



## REMOVE SPOTS FROM YOUR wooden surfaces

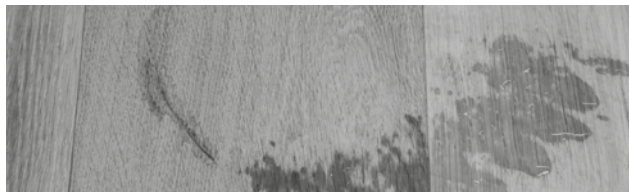
### WOOD STAIN REMOVER

Wood Stain Remover effectively dissolves grease, blood, coffee, tea etc. May be used on unfinished, soaped, oiled or waxed interior surfaces. Stain Remover is based on soap and specially developed for indoor use to remove stains from oiled wood surfaces.



### TANNIN SPOT REMOVER

Tannin Spot Remover effectively removes black spots caused by acid/water reaction. May be used on unfinished, soaped, oiled or waxed interior surfaces.

## REGULAR CLEANING

simple and fast



### NATURAL SOAP

- Nourishing effect
- For the basic treatment of softwood
- For regularly cleaning



#### WORKFLOW

**1** Natural Soap is shaken carefully before use. Make sure the pigments are mixed well.

**2** 125 ml Natural Soap is mixed into 5 L of cold water.

**3** Wipe down the surface with a well-wrung mop.

**NB!** Use mops with high cotton content. Don't use mops containing microfiber only.

Clean the floor with minimum quantity of water – leave soap water on floor briefly in order to dissolve dirt. Remove dirty soap water with hard-wrung mop or cloth and rinse out in bucket with rinsing water.

**For best results, use two buckets:** One with the soap solution and the second with clean water to rinse the dirty mop.

## REGULAR REFRESHING

every fourth time



### OIL REFRESHING SOAP

- Enhances the natural colour of the wood
- Cleans and maintains the floor gently
- Leaves a mat protecting oil film on the wood surface



#### WORKFLOW

**1** Shake the container well before use. Make sure the pigments are mixed well.

**2** Mix Oil Refreshing Soap with lukewarm water: – For UV-oiled and oil-waxed floors: 125 ml soap into 5 L of water. The mixture ratio can vary depending on wear.

**3** Damp mop the floor lengthwise with the soap water. It is recommended to clean an area of approx. 10 m<sup>2</sup>. ft. at a time.

**4** Leave wood to dry for approx. 2 hours before use.

**5** If a light shine is wanted, polish the dry floor with a white pad.

**For best results, use two buckets:** One with soap water and the second with clean water to rinse the dirty mop.

## REJUVENATE

when needed



### STEP 1 - INTENSIVE WOOD CLEANER

- Prepares surfaces for additional treatment
- Basic cleaning and grease removal
- High efficiency



#### WORKFLOW

**1** Mix 250 ml of Intensive Wood Cleaner with 5 L warm water.

**2** Wipe the wood surface with a well-wrung mop. For best results, leave Wood Cleaner solution on the surface to work for 5 minutes and wipe again with clean water. If necessary, the surface can be cleaned with a hand-held pad or a floor machine. If the surface is very dirty, repeat.

**3** Let the surface dry completely before subsequent treatment.

### STEP 2 - MAINTENANCE GEL

- Especially suitable for UV-oiled surfaces
- Excellent results on factory-oiled surfaces
- Makes surfaces even more durable



#### WORKFLOW

**1** Apply an appropriate amount of gel to a red/white WOCA Hand Scrubber and distribute over the surface in a thin, even coat. Continue polishing until the wood seems saturated and the surface has a uniform appearance. It is recommended to work on small areas at a time, as the gel is quick-drying. For larger areas (floors larger than 10 m<sup>2</sup>) it would be advantageous to use a polishing machine.

**2** Immediately wipe down the polished surface with a clean, dry lint-free cotton cloth. When prepping with a machine, the final polishing should be done with a cotton cloth beneath the buffer. The surface should not appear wet and no excess gel should remain on the surface.

**3** If the wood does not seem fully saturated after 4-6 hours, it would be advantageous to repolish, with less gel than the first treatment, but following the same procedure.

**4** Wait 4-6 hours before using the surface. Avoid getting water or dirt on the wooden surface for the next 2-3 days.
