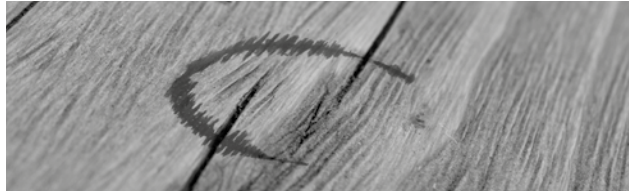




## REMOVE SPOTS FROM YOUR wooden surfaces

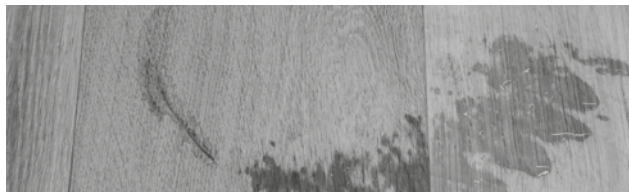
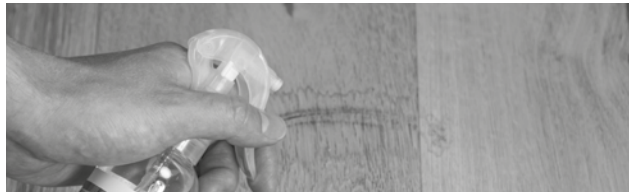
### WOOD STAIN REMOVER

Wood Stain Remover effectively dissolves grease, blood, coffee, tea etc. May be used on unfinished, soaped, oiled or waxed interior surfaces. Stain Remover is based on soap and specially developed for indoor use to remove stains from oiled wood surfaces.



### TANNIN SPOT REMOVER

Tannin Spot Remover effectively removes black spots caused by acid/water reaction. May be used on unfinished, soaped, oiled or waxed interior surfaces.

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## REGULAR CLEANING

### NATURAL SOAP

- Nourishing effect
- For the basic treatment of softwood
- For regularly cleaning



#### WORKFLOW

**1** Natural Soap is shaken carefully before use. Make sure the pigments are mixed well.

**2** 125 ml of Natural Soap is mixed into 5L of cold water.

**3** Damp mop the surface with a well wrung mop.

**NB!** Use mops with high cotton content. Don't use mops containing microfiber only.

Clean the floor with minimum quantity of water – leave soap water on floor briefly in order to dissolve dirt. Remove dirty soap water with hard-wrung mop or cloth and rinse out in bucket with rinsing water.

**For best results, use two buckets:** One with the soap solution and the second with clean water to rinse the dirty mop.

## REGULAR REFRESHING

every fourth time



### OIL REFRESHING SOAP

- Enhances the natural colour of the wood
- Cleans and maintains the floor gently
- Leaves a mat protecting oil film on the wood surface



#### WORKFLOW

**1** Shake the container well before use. Make sure the pigments are mixed well.

**2** Mix Oil Refreshing Soap with lukewarm water: – For traditionally oiled floors: 250 ml soap with 5 L of water. – The mixture ratio can vary depending on wear.

**3** Damp mop the floor lengthwise with the soap water. It is recommended to clean an area of approx. 10 m<sup>2</sup>. ft. at a time.

**4** Leave wood to dry for approx. 2 hours before use.

**5** If a light shine is wanted, polish the dry floor with a white pad.

**For best results, use two buckets:** One with soap water and the second with clean water to rinse the dirty mop.

## REJUVENATE

when needed



### STEP 1 - INTENSIVE WOOD CLEANER

- Prepares surfaces for additional treatment
- Basic cleaning and grease removal
- High efficiency



#### WORKFLOW

**1** Mix 250 ml of Intensive Wood Cleaner with 5 L warm water.

**2** Wipe the wood surface with a well-wrung mop. For best results, leave Wood Cleaner solution on the surface to work for 5 minutes and wipe again with clean water. If necessary, the surface can be cleaned with a hand-held pad or a floor machine. If the surface is very dirty, repeat.

**3** Let the surface dry completely before subsequent treatment.



### STEP 2 - INVISIBLE OIL CARE

- Cares for and maintains floors that have been treated with Invisible Oil Primer and Invisible Oil
- Resistant to liquids such as water, coffee, tea and red wine
- Gives the wood a beautiful, breathable soft feel surface



#### WORKFLOW

**1** Thoroughly shake the container, both before and during use.

**2** Apply Invisible Oil Care in a thin and even coat, using the WOCA Oil applicator or a wool pad and pad holder. Work in small areas of no more than 20 m<sup>2</sup> at a time.

**3** Carefully polish the area with a white pad. Use a polishing machine for larger surfaces. Continue polishing until the wood is completely saturated and the surface has a uniform appearance.

**4** Remove excess oil care with dry, lint-free cotton cloths or pads attached to the polishing machine until the surface no longer appears wet.

**5** The surface can be used with caution after 6-12 hours and is fully hardened after 5 days at room temperature.

Do not expose the floor to water or other liquids for the first 5 days, while Invisible Oil Care is hardening.
